

THIS IS SCANIA ZONE

Scania Zone is a position-based system for real-time vehicle adjustments in pre-defined zones. It allows you to set conditions for the vehicles connected.

A connected vehicle with a Scania Zone subscription can be managed from your office through the Scania Fleet Management Portal.

Scania Zone contributes to a safer, cleaner and more quiet city by letting you easily set restrictions for your vehicles.



IT BENEFITS YOU

For you as an operator, Scania Zone supports:

SAFETY

Monitor speed of your fleet in sensitive areas like construction zones, transport terminals and bus depots by off-board setting of speed conditions.

FUEL SAVINGS

Reduce fuel consumption by lowering speed in defined speed zones.

GOOD WORK ENVIRONMENT

Pre-set zone restrictions ensure safer and less stressful work environment for your drivers.

COMPLIANCE

Meet requirements of Zone Management functionality set by Public Transport Authorities in tender business.

REPORTING FUNCTIONALITY

By connectivity, the vehicle recognizes when it enters a zone and adapts to set restrictions.

If there is a violation to zone restrictions, an indication is sent to the Fleet Management Portal and via e-mail to the operator.

The reporting tool allows the operator to easily follow-up on deviations of zone restrictions, whether driver- or vehicle related. The reported data is available in flexible format.





SCANIA ZONE

GEOGRAPHICAL ZONES CAN BE:

- Informative the driver gets an indication in the dashboard when entering/leaving a zone.
- Auto-compliant the vehicle adjusts automatically to meet the set restrictions.

The driver may always override the automatic adjustments.

PREREQUISITES:

To be able to benefit from Scania Zone, you will need:

- A connected compatible Scania vehicle.*
- A Scania Zone subscription.

As well as one of the below:

- Scania Positioning Standalone Package, or;
- Scania Fleet Management Control Package.

*A truck produced after June 2019 or a bus of the new generation.
