

BEFORE YOU SET OFF



Monitor weather and road conditions

Regularly check weather forecasts and road conditions along the route. Be prepared to adjust plans based on current conditions.

Flexible routing

Plan alternative routes to avoid areas experiencing severe weather or heavy traffic.

Allow extra time

Allocate additional time for deliveries to account for possible delays due to weather or road conditions.

Our Fleet Position Package can show you live traffic information, you can analyse your route for roadworks, accidents, and any height, weight and width restrictions and pre plan your route including any rest stops.

COMMUNICATION AND COORDINATION

Stay in touch

Keep regular communication with customers, drivers and other relevant parties to update them on progress and any potential delays.

Real-time updates

Set up Geofencing through our Fleet Position package so you receive notifications when deliveries are made or when a vehicle is approaching a customer site.

Or provide customers with an ETA based on real-time information. With visibility of driving time and rest periods you can offer accurate information without the need of calling the driver.





FUEL MANAGEMENT

Keep the tank full

Maintain a full fuel tank to prevent condensation from forming in the fuel lines and to ensure you have enough fuel to reach your destination or a safe stop.

Plan refuelling stops

Be aware of fuel stations along the route, especially in remote areas where stations may be farther apart.

With our Fleet Position package you can view fuel and reductant levels in real-time (1 minute updates) for vehicles with a factory fitted fuel-theft alarm, receive SMS or email notifications when a tampering event is detected.



LOAD MANAGEMENT

Proper loading

Ensure the load is properly secured and balanced to maintain stability, especially in slippery conditions.

Check for weight limits

Be mindful of weight limits and distribution, as overloading can exacerbate control issues on icy or snowy roads.

Through our Fleet Position package you can view axle weights and spot any loading issues or if a trailer is empty.

This information is available for vehicles with air suspension and with a C300 V2.5 $\!\!\!^{\circ}$.





LOOSE OR MISSING WHEEL NUTS

Wheel nuts are essential for securing the wheel to the hub. If they are not properly tightened, they can loosen over time due to vibrations and eventually fall off, causing the wheel to detach.

ROAD CONDITIONS AND IMPACT

Hitting a pothole, kerb, or other obstacle can cause damage to the wheel, hub, or suspension components, potentially leading to wheel detachment.

OVER-TIGHTENING OR UNDER-TIGHTENING

Both over-tightening and under-tightening wheel nuts can cause problems.

Over-tightening can stretch or damage the wheel studs, while under-tightening can lead to loosening.

Both scenarios can lead to loose wheel nuts or broken studs.



BEARING FAILURE

The wheel bearing supports the wheel and allows it to rotate smoothly. If the bearing fails, it can cause excessive play in the wheel, which may eventually lead to the wheel coming off.

BRAKE DRUM OR DISC ISSUES

Problems with the brake drum or disc, such as improper installation or damage, can affect the wheel's stability.

HUB OR AXLE DAMAGE

Damage to the hub or axle can also lead to wheel detachment. This can be due to wear and tear, accidents, or poor maintenance.

Prevent axle damage with a regular wheel alignment from £289.00° per axle on a single steer and £439.00° on twin steer axles.



CORROSION AND RUST

Corrosion can weaken wheel components, making them more susceptible to failure. This is especially common in areas with harsh weather conditions or road salt usage.


