Battery capacity

Cold temperatures can reduce a battery's capacity to hold a charge, making it difficult to provide the necessary power to start the engine.

Starter motor

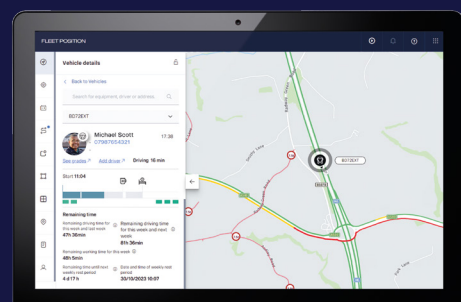

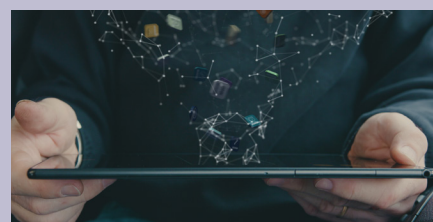
Stay in touch

FUEL MANAGEMENT

Keep the tank full

Maintain a full fuel tank to prevent condensation from forming in the fuel lines and to ensure you have enough fuel to reach your destination or a safe stop.

Plan refuelling stops

Be aware of fuel stations along the route, especially in remote areas where stations may be farther apart.

With our Fleet Position package you can view fuel and reductant levels in real-time (1 minute updates) for vehicles with a factory fitted fuel-theft alarm, receive SMS or email notifications when a tampering event is detected.



LOAD MANAGEMENT

Proper loading

Ensure the load is properly secured and balanced to maintain stability, especially in slippery conditions.

Check for weight limits

Be mindful of weight limits and distribution, as overloading can exacerbate control issues on icy or snowy roads.

Through our Fleet Position package you can view axle weights and spot any loading issues or if a trailer is empty.

WHEEL SAFETY

WHAT CAN CAUSE WHEEL LOSS?

A truck wheel can come off for various reasons, here are some common causes:



LOOSE OR MISSING WHEEL NUTS

Wheel nuts are essential for securing the wheel to the hub. If they are not properly tightened, they can loosen over time due to vibrations and eventually fall off, causing the wheel to detach.

ROAD CONDITIONS AND IMPACT

Hitting a pothole, kerb, or other obstacle can cause damage to the wheel, hub, or suspension components, potentially leading to wheel detachment.

OVER-TIGHTENING OR UNDER-TIGHTENING

Both over-tightening and under-tightening wheel nuts can cause problems. Over-tightening can stretch or damage the wheel studs, while under-tightening can lead to loosening. Both scenarios can lead to loose wheel nuts or broken studs.

BEARING FAILURE

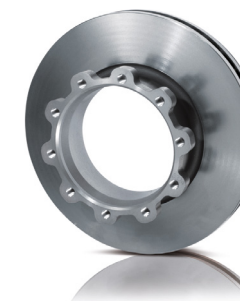
The wheel bearing supports the wheel and allows it to rotate smoothly. If the bearing fails, it can cause excessive play in the wheel, which may eventually lead to the wheel coming off.

HUB OR AXLE DAMAGE

Damage to the hub or axle can also lead to wheel detachment. This can be due to wear and tear, accidents, or poor maintenance.

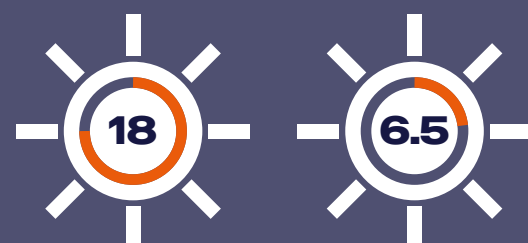

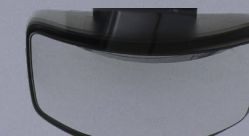

SAFE DRIVING

OUR TOP TIPS FROM SCANIA DRIVER TRAINERS

Improving driving skills in winter conditions is absolutely crucial for truck drivers to ensure not only their own safety but also the safety of everyone on the road. Winter driving presents unique challenges, and adopting the right strategies can make all the difference.

Here are some key practices every truck driver should follow:

Be cautious with braking

When roads are slick, be mindful of how you brake. Over-reliance on the retarder can cause wheel lockup on icy surfaces, so use it carefully. Instead, use gentle engine braking or light applications of your service brakes. If your wheels begin to skid, ease off and regain control.

Reducing speed isn't just a suggestion – it's a necessity

Slower speeds give you more time to react. Excessive acceleration can cause wheels to lose traction and skid. Coasting allows the truck to maintain momentum without adding power that could lead to a loss of grip.

Avoid sudden movements

Smooth steering and braking are essential to prevent skidding. Sudden movements can cause a loss of traction, so keep your actions slow and controlled. Increase your following distance to allow more reaction time.

Idle wisely during cold starts

Idling in winter keeps the engine warm and prevents fuel gelling, but excessive idling wastes fuel and causes engine wear. Idle briefly for cold starts, then drive slowly to complete the warm-up efficiently.

Anticipate reduced visibility

Anticipate reduced visibility from fog, snow, or spray by adjusting speed early and using low beams or fog lights to reduce glare. Ensure windscreen wipers work properly and clear snow or ice regularly to maintain visibility. Stay prepared for these conditions to drive safely in winter.

Maintain lane discipline

Avoid sudden lane changes and make sure to stay in well-cleared areas. Be mindful of sitting in others' blind spots to reduce the risk of collisions.

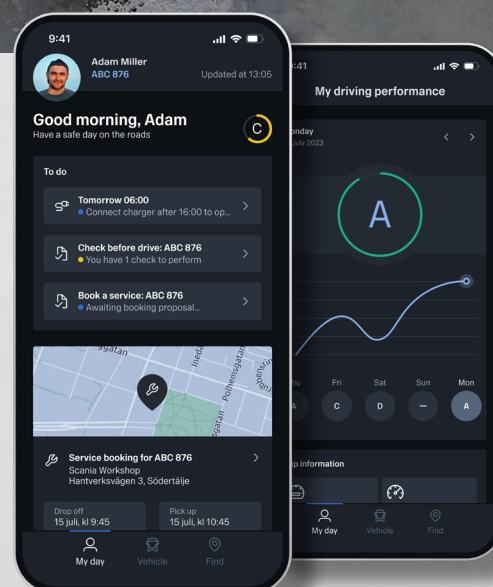
DRIVER EVALUATION

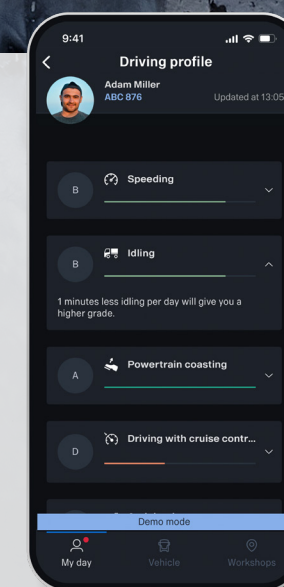

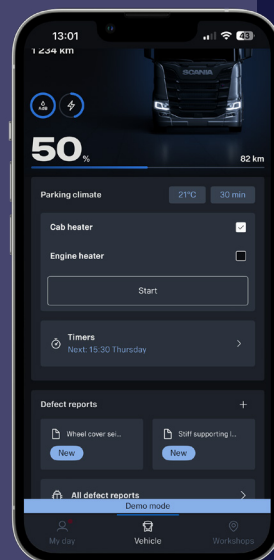
In addition to these physical risks, truck drivers face increased isolation during winter, which can impact mental health, especially during the holiday season.

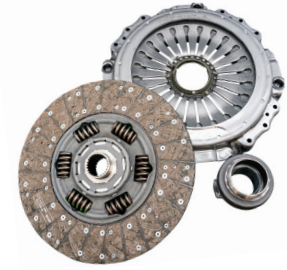

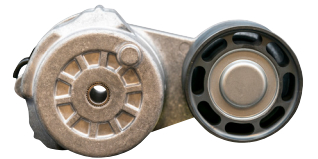

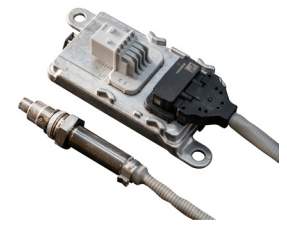
