

SCANIA (GREAT BRITAIN) LIMITED TERMS OF USE FOR THE SCANIA FIXED PRICE REPAIR OFFER AND CALCULATOR

- 1. Scania (Great Britain) Limited standard terms and conditions of sale apply to the Fixed Price Repair programme. These are available upon request from www.scania.co.uk/terms.
- 2. The Fixed Price Repair programme is only available for retail sales only.
- 3. Available at participating branches only.
- 4. Fitted prices include inspection, diagnosis, verbal assessment; Scania specified parts, labour and consumables.
- 5. All prices exclude VAT at the standard rate.
- 6. The published prices apply to the job described which includes specific part numbers & RTS codes and do not apply to other similar jobs available from Scania branches.
- 7. The Fixed Price Repair prices cannot be used in conjunction with any other discount or promotion.
- 8. Scania reserves the right to alter any specification and price without notice.
- 9. An additional uplift in labour will be applied to the Fixed Price Repair if work is carried out between 20:00 and 06:00 at any Scania branch.
- 10. All prices assume presentation of the vehicle, by the customer, to the repairing branch
- 11. Additional breakdown related charges will apply if the vehicle has suffered an involuntary stop at the roadside.
- 12. The Fixed Price Repair jobs published are created using Scania standard times based on standard Scania vehicle specifications and do not include the additional labour required for the removal of catwalks, ancillary equipment, bodywork, superstructures or any non-standard equipment fitted to the vehicle. Additional time required to complete the job in respect of these items will be agreed with the customer prior to any work being carried out.
- 13. All Service Exchange parts carry a parts surcharge; this surcharge cost is additional to the Fixed Price Repair price.
- 14. All information related to the Fixed Price Repair programme is believed to be correct at the time of going to press, however, Scania reserves the right to introduce at any time, modifications or changes





to the jobs and or programme as part of a policy of continuous improvement.
